CONSTITUTION AMENDMENT BILL (No.1) 2016

SAMOA

Explanatory Memorandum

Objects and reasons:

The object of the Bill is to repeal Article 41A of the Constitution of the Independent State of Samoa 1960 in order to remove the constitutional appointment of the Director of Public Prosecutions. The Bill will also amend Article 41 to reinstate the Attorney General's prosecutorial powers. This decision has been made on the premise that Government had thought at the time the new National Prosecution Office was set up, that Samoa was ready to set up this new Office. However there were no issues in the past with the Attorney General carrying out prosecutorial duties independently. Given recent developments with the set-up of the National Prosecution Office, Government has decided to return to the way things were i.e. for the Attorney General to once again assume the role of prosecution which will be done as before, with independence and without influence.

Clauses:

<u>Clause 1</u>: - provides the short title and commencement provisions.

<u>Clause 2</u>: - repeals Article 41A to remove the appointment of a person

as the Director of Public Prosecutions.

<u>Clause 3</u>: - amends Article 41 to reinstate the Attorney General's

prosecutorial powers.

<u>Clause 4</u>: - consequentially amends:

- (1) the National Prosecution Office Act 2015 is repealed.
- (2) the Acts set out in the Schedule of the National Prosecution Office Act 2015 are amended.

Schedule: - sets out the consequential amendments to other Acts.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Constitution of the Independent State of Samoa 1960 ("Constitution").

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of Samoa in Parliament assembled as follows:

1. Short title and commencement:

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Constitution Amendment Act (No.1) 2016.
- (2) This Act commences on the date of assent by the Head of State.

2. Article 41A repealed:

Article 41A of the Constitution is repealed.

3. Article 41 amended:

For Article 41 of the Constitution, substitute:

"41. Attorney-General:

- (1) The Head of State, acting on the advice of the Prime Minister, shall appoint an Attorney-General, who shall be a person qualified to be a Judge of the Supreme Court.
- (2) The Attorney-General shall advise on legal matters referred to him by the Head of State, Cabinet, the Prime Minister or a Minister and shall have power, exercisable in his discretion, to institute, conduct or discontinue any proceedings for an offence alleged to have been committed.
- (3) The Attorney-General shall have a right of audience in, and shall take precedence over any other person appearing before, any Court or tribunal.
- (4) The powers of the Attorney-General may be exercised by him in person or by officers subordinate to him, acting under and in accordance with his general or special instructions.

(5) The Attorney-General shall hold office for such term or terms and under such conditions as may be determined by the Head of State, acting on the advice of the Prime Minister.".

4. Consequential amendments:

- (1) The National Prosecution Office Act 2015 is repealed.
- (2) The Acts set out in the Schedule are amended.
- (3) Upon the commencement of the Evidence Act 2015, the Criminal Procedure Act 2016 and the Sentencing Act 2016, all references to the Director of Public Prosecutions is to be omitted and substituted with the Attorney General.

5. Transitional Provision:

At the commencement of this Act:

- (a) any current criminal proceedings instituted and conducted for and on behalf of the Director of Public Prosecutions or the Police are to continue as if they were instituted and conducted by the Attorney General;
- (b) any current proceedings for other statutory offences or traffic offences continue to be dealt with under their respective enactments until they are transferred by Order of the Minister;

- (c) any current staff of the National Prosecution Office are considered as part of the Prosecution Division of the Attorney General's Office;
- (d) a Tribunal appointed pursuant to section 11(4) of the National Prosecution Office Act 2015 may continue and its recommendation is valid as if the National Prosecution Office Act 2015 had not been repealed.
