Explanatory Memorandum

Introduction:

The Bill seeks to amend the Constitution of the Independent State of Samoa 1960 ("Constitution"). The object of the Bill is to insert in the Constitution that Samoa is a Christian nation to declare the dominance of Christianity in Samoa.

Clauses:

<u>Clause 1</u>: - provides for the short title and commencement of the

Bill, which will commence on the date of assent.

<u>Clause 2</u>: - amends Article 1 of the Constitution by inserting a new

sub Article (3).

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Constitution of the Independent State of Samoa 1960 ("Constitution").

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of Samoa in Parliament assembled as follows:

1. Short title and commencement:

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Constitution Amendment Act (No.2) 2016.
- (2) This Act commences on the date of assent by the Head of State.

2. Article 1 amended:

For Article 1 of the Constitution, after sub Article (2), insert:

"(3) Samoa is a Christian nation founded on God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.".
