AN ACT to amend the Crimes Act 2013 ("Principal Act") and other related purposes. [21st December 2017]

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of Samoa in Parliament assembled as follows:

1. Short title and commencement:

(1) This Act may be cited as the Crimes Amendment Act 2017.

(2) This Act commences on the date of its assent by the Head of State.

2. New Part 9A inserted:

The Principal Act is amended by inserting a new Part 9A after section 117 as follows:

"PART 9A CRIMES AGAINST A PERSON'S REPUTATION

117A. False statement causing harm to a person's reputation:

- (1) A person commits an offence who publishes by any means information:
 - (a) about another person;
 - (b) that is false;
 - (c) with the intention to cause harm to that person's reputation.
- (2) It is a defence under this section if the information published is true.
- (3) A person who commits a crime under this section is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding 175 penalty units or imprisonment for a term not exceeding three (3) months.".

The Crimes Amendment Act 2017 is administered by the Ministry of Police.
