PROHIBITION ORDER ON THE IMPORTATION OF EGGS WITHOUT SELL - BY DATE (OR BEST BEFORE DATE OR EXPIRATION DATE)

I, TUI ATUA TUPUA TAMASESE EFI, Head of State of the Independent State of Samoa, acting pursuant to section 49 of the Customs Act 1977, and being of the opinion that such prohibition is necessary in the public interest, **DO HEREBY PROHIBIT** the importation of all eggs without sell-by date (or best before date or expiration date), on egg cartons and trays.

This Order comes into force 3 months from the date of the Order.
