## REGULATIONS

**1.** Short title and commencement-(1) These regulations may be cited as the Customs Amendment Regulations 2011 and shall be read together with and form part of the Customs Regulations 1986 ("Principal Regulations") and the Customs Amendment Regulations 1998, as relevant.

(2) These regulations commence on 1 July 2011.

**2.** Licence fee - In regulation 87 of the Principal Regulations, for "\$500" substitute "\$670".

**3. Increased rates for certain customs fees** - In the Schedule to the Customs Amendment Regulations 1998:

- (a) in respect of the fee payable for an application for bonded areas, for "\$500" substitute "\$670"; and
- (b) in relation to the fee payable for an application for a deferred duty, for "\$25 per application" substitute "\$35 per application".
