ORDER FOR THE DECLARATION OF THE DAYLIGHT SAVING PERIOD 2012 AND 2013

I, TUI ATUA TUPUA TAMASESE EFI, Head of State, acting on the advice of Cabinet, make this Order pursuant to section 3 of the Daylight Saving Act 2009, to **DECLARE**:

SUNDAY, 30 SEPTEMBER 2012, AT 3 A.M., AND ENDING ON SUNDAY, 7 APRIL 2013, AT 4 A.M. <u>AND</u> SUNDAY, 29 SEPTEMBER 2013, AT 3 A.M., AND ENDING ON SUNDAY, 6 APRIL 2014, AT 4 A.M.

as the daylight saving period. During the daylight saving period, the time for general purposes throughout Samoa must be in advance of the standard time by one hour.

When the daylight saving period ends on Sunday, 7 April 2013 at 4 a.m. and 6 April 2014 at 4 a.m. the time must revert by one hour to the standard time.
