## PUBLIC BODIES (PERFORMANCE AND ACCOUNTABILITY) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (No.2) 2013

Arrangement of Provisions

## REGULATIONS

- **1. Short title and commencement**-(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Public Bodies (Performance and Accountability) Amendment Regulations (No.2) 2013, and shall be read with and form part of the Public Bodies (Performance and Accountability) Act 2001 (hereinafter called the 'Principal Act').
- (2) These Regulations come into effect on the date they are made by the Head of State.
- **2. Schedule 3**-(1) In Part A of Schedule 3 of the Principal Act, after 3.1.1, insert:
  - "3.1.2 For the purposes of section 28 and subject to the empowering Act, the Cabinet may, in writing, direct the Chief Executive Officer of the Ministry of Finance to attend and participate in the meeting of any board of a public trading body of which the Chief Executive Officer is not a member.
  - 3.1.3 If the Chief Executive Officer of the Ministry of Finance is unavailable to attend under Item 3.1.2, he or she may authorise a senior officer from the Ministry of Finance to attend, and participate in that meeting as his or her representative.
  - 3.1.4 The Chief Executive Officer of the Ministry of Finance or his or her authorised representative does not have voting rights.
  - 3.1.5 Items 3.1.2 to 3.1.4 do not apply to a board of a public trading body where the Chief Executive Officer of the Ministry of Finance is a member.".

- (2) For the provision in Part B of Schedule 3 of the Principal Act, substitute "The above provisions in Part A shall apply to Public Beneficial Bodies.".
