REGULATIONS

1. Citation and commencement - These Regulations may be cited as the Public Bodies (Election Candidates) Regulations 2015 and commence on the date they are signed by the Head of State.

- **2. Resignation for election candidates**-(1) For the purpose of section 8 of the Electoral Act 1963, an employee of a public body must resign from his or her employment by giving at least three (3) months' notice before the expiry of the term of Parliament.
 - (2) In this regulation, "employee":
 - (a) includes the chief executive officer (by whatever name called) or a director or a member of the board of a public body; but
 - (b) does not include an employee, director or member who is currently -
 - (i) a Member of Parliament (including a Minister); or
 - (ii) a Chief Executive Officer of a Ministry who is a director or member of the board of a public body.
