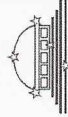

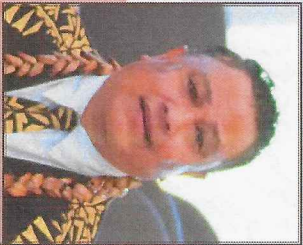

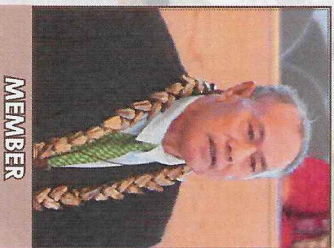


Economic Sector Committee

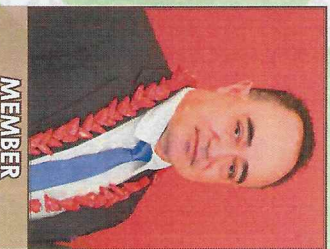
