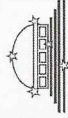

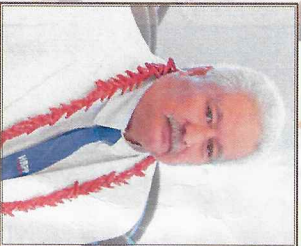
Standing Orders, Electoral, Petition & Constitutional Officers Committee

Consider and report back to the Assembly on Annual Reports or other Reports from Government Ministries and State owned Enterprises (SOEs). Consider and report to the Assembly any proposal for the amendment of Standing Orders as stated under Standing Orders 72 all and other matters relating to these Orders which may be referred to it by the Assembly. Conduct a review of the Standing Orders towards the end of each Parliament term which is to be approved by the Assembly before Parliament dissolves. Consider any Bill, Petition, Report or other matter referred by the Assembly or the Standing Orders. Conduct a review of the Electoral Act once during the 18 month period before Parliament dissolves. Examine the administration and expenditures of the Office of the Electoral Commissioner. Allocate its work to other Parliamentary Committees if required.

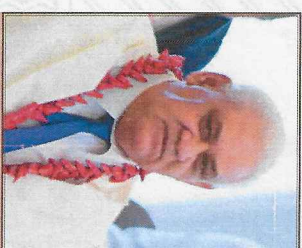
